### Clean Coal Faculty Position

The College of Engineering and Computing at the University of South Carolina seeks to hire a cluster of faculty members with research and teaching expertise in the area of Clean Coal. The senior candidate of this cluster is expected to play a leadership role as an Endowed Chair holder in the Center for Clean Coal (CCC). This Center has an endowment of \$7.5 MM with an additional one-time allotment of up to \$2.5 MM for start-up expenditures. The holder of the Endowed Chair is expected to maintain a nationally recognized externally funded research program, to interact with industry, federal and state agencies and to provide vision and leadership in the selection of the remaining members of the cluster. Candidates for the lead position are expected to have an international reputation in the field and a record of achievement consistent with the granting of tenure at the rank of Professor in the Chemical or Mechanical Engineering Departments. Additional members of the cluster are also expected to develop strong educational and externally-funded research programs in areas related to the Center and to collaborate with the Endowed Chair holder. Tenured or tenure-track appointments will be made in either of the two departments mentioned above at a rank commensurate with the candidates' credentials.
