Patterson joined Intel in 2011 to lead Intel Federal, which focuses on providing innovative information technology solutions to the U.S. government, including the intelligence community, the defense department and civilian agencies. He has a background in manufacturing, consulting and technical services, and has worked extensively in support of the U.S. government since Sept. 11, 2001, including work with the U.S. Departments of Homeland Security, Defense, Energy, State and Transportation, as well as the intelligence community.

Before joining Intel, Patterson was president and chief executive officer of other technology companies, serving as the senior executive sponsor of programs addressing some of the most challenging issues facing the United States.
